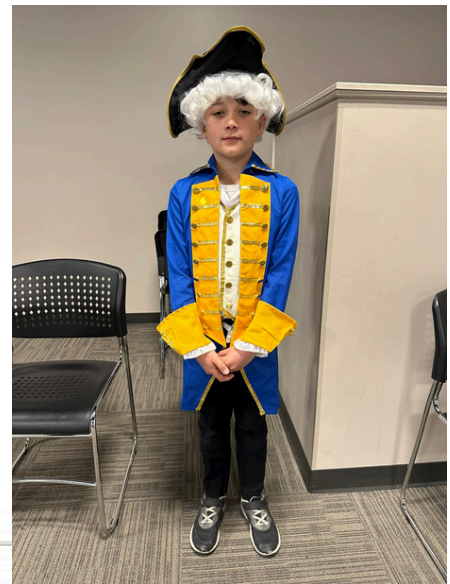
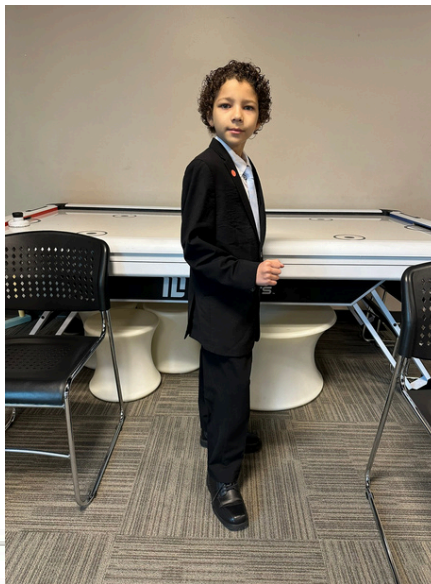


# EXPLORING LIVES, CRAFTING NARRATIVES: SECOND GRADERS DIVE INTO BIOGRAPHY READING AND WRITING
