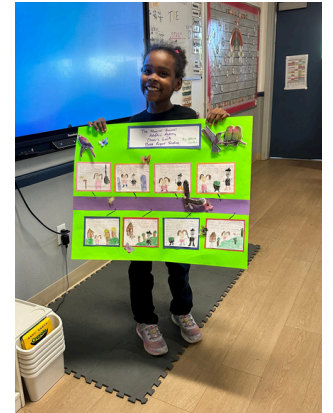
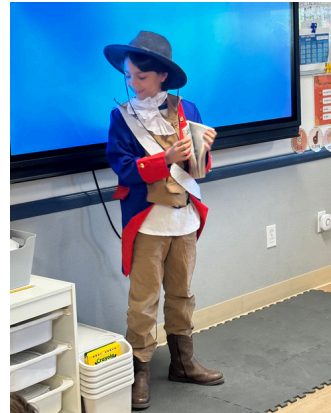
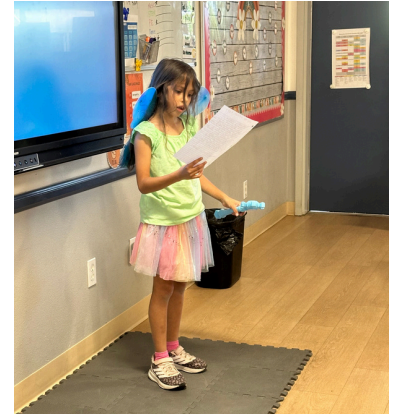
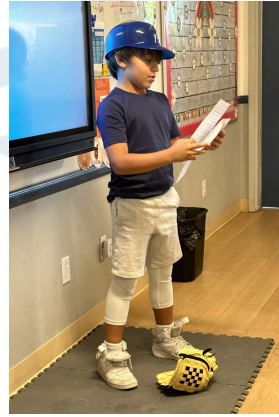


CREATIVE BOOK REPORTS SHOWCASE
