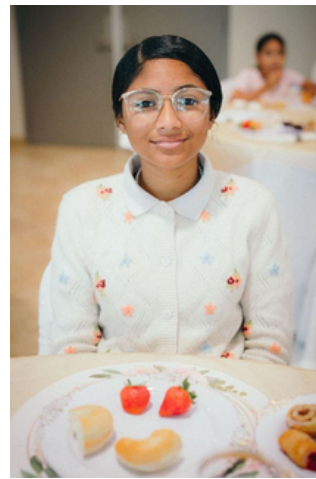
Developing Critical Thinking Through Historical Perspective
