Some of the recent additions and upgrades include: new playground for preschool, new playground for Elementary, STEM Makerspace, science lab; outdoor sports court, bleachers in the gym, renovated athletic field, new technology network to increase campus bandwidth and technology infrastructure; 15 Promethean boards for all classrooms; one-to-one access for classroom personal devices; STEM curriculum with educational resources; sports equipment and uniforms; outdoor education patio with shade and seating; full renovation of preschool including: floors, ceilings, lights heating, air conditioning, new windows and lighting, classroom furnishings, storage, Discovery Zone, outdoor sandbox, sound system, outdoor patio rubber playing surface, entry gates, resource room for educational resources; Follet inventory management system; teacher funding for classroom educational resources; security perimeter fencing; security intercom system; door management system; remote wireless locking devices; controlled entry points; electric security gates; new flooring in 20 classrooms; new math, writing and science curriculums; nation-leading benchmark-testing resource to target each students' math and language arts skill gap; painted exterior buildings; indoor and outdoor all-campus sound/music system, carline dismissal intercom system; portable outdoor sound systems; new classroom bell system; safety all-call system for active shooter emergency situations; 7000 square feet of playground shade structures; a 30x60 fenced-in soccer arena; and leveling and resurfacing grass sports field.

These reimagined spaces will nurture competencies in technology, web design, health services, business acumen, language acquisition, sound and light engineering, literacy, critical thinking, and the integration of Biblical principles into everyday learning. The primary goal is to immerse our students in real-world problem-solving experiences, empowering them to become proactive agents of change and cultivating future leaders with a deep sense of purpose. As part of this initiative, WVCS seeks collaboration with a prominent national non-profit to explore sustainable solutions aimed at addressing global poverty. Our aspiration is to harness our students' STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) resources and capabilities to foster innovative approaches towards alleviating societal challenges.
