BUILDING CONFIDENCE THROUGH LEARNING BUTTONS

Each morning in preschool begins with a warm welcome button, helping children separate smoothly from parents and feel comfortable starting their day. This thoughtful routine provides stability and reassurance, setting a positive tone for all the learning to come.

From there, our students dive into learning buttons and stations that reinforce weekly concepts. These include practicing curved lines, reviewing shapes and colors, and soon, exploring the letter and number of the week. By offering hands-on, interactive activities, children get to explore academic skills in a way that feels playful and exciting. These moments reflect Guided Experience (G), as teachers introduce new skills through engaging activities, while also fostering Work & Wonder Together (W), as children learn kindness and collaboration during shared play.

These activities are also designed to encourage confidence and self-reflection. As students revisit concepts through repetition, they see their own progress and begin to recognize how much they are learning. The result is a joyful and engaging classroom environment where children are not only growing in knowledge, but also in self-awareness and independence.
