




A Little Bit About me!

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Summertime Prep Ideas for TK

- Read to your child for at least 15 min. each night
- Practice writing name
- Practice letter and sound recognition
- Practice identifying numbers 1-10

Social emotional/Self help skills:

- Schedule playdates- practice sharing, taking turns, listening, and cooperating with others
- Practice opening and closing backpack, lunch box, containers, fastening ziploc bags
- Practice tying shoes, Zipping, and buttoning
- Practice using restroom by themselves
- Practice independent tasks
- Sleep is important. Before school starts, sync bedtime and wake up times to the upcoming school schedule

<u>Fine Motor Skills:</u>

- Practice cutting and holding scissors correctly
- Play with Playdough/Silly Putty
- Practice correct pencil grip
